Our schedule necessitated a return trip to the People's Republic of California (sorry!), where we have enjoyed fellowship and a couple of visits already since returning at the end of July. In our last letter, we were in Nevada with an upcoming trip through Northern California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Montana.

After visiting churches in almost all of those States, we took our first trip to Canada, visiting with five new churches in Alberta. There was even a person that trusted Christ as Saviour during our first meeting, and we thank the LORD for the opportunity to proclaim the gospel. We appreciate all those churches' generosity and hospitality, and we enjoyed meeting folks up and down the QE2.

There are many thousands of miles of travel in store before we get to go home to Chile, as well as numerous tanks of costly diesel, so please pray for our safety on the road, and the LORD's provision as we travel and try to raise some desperately needed support.

Furlough has also been very costly, and we have been backwards on expenses more than once over the last few months. Please pray for **provision for us**, as well as **some savings** for our return to Chile.

Finally, we want to thank the LORD for some **monthly support for Bro. Luís Huerta**, the Peruvian national that is covering for us while we travel. However, starting a new family is costly and he could definitely use your support if you were so inclined.

Thank you again for your faithful prayers and financial support. We appreciate everything done on our behalf.
